The high stakes polling for the Shimla Municipal Corporation (SMC) held on Tuesday witnessed 58.66 percent of voter turnout for the 34 wards.

The polling was held on party symbols for the 34 wards seats had 102 candidates in fray from Congress, BJP, CPI(M) and AAP.

The polling percentage recorded in the Shimla Municipal Corporation elections was 58.66 percent.

Of the total 93920 voters 55098 voted which included 29335 (58.95 percent) male voters while 25763 (58.34 percent) were female voters.

For the 34 wards about 50 percent are reserved for

women 6 for Scheduled caste (including 3 women), while 14 are unreserved.

The polling that commenced at 8.00 am started with a low key note due to the

Haryana's GST collection up by 22%

Goods and Services Tax (GST) collection has gone up by 22 percent in Haryana, according to the data released by the Union finance ministry.

An official spokesperson said the state's GST collection was Rs 8,197 Crore in the year 2022 and now this has increased to Rs 10,035 crore in the year 2023.

"Compared to Haryana's GST collection with the neighbouring states, Punjab has an increase of 16 per cent, 17 per cent in Himachal Pradesh, eight per cent in Delhi and five per cent in Rajasthan. These figures clearly show that Haryana's growth rate is certainly more than these states," he added.

Expressing happiness over the figures released by the Union government, the Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar said Haryana has made remarkable progress in GST collection, which shows that

the state is progressing.

"Haryana is one of the leading states on the parameters of economic development. The state government is giving all required facilities to big industries as well as Micro, Small and Medium industries. The state government has also improved power availability and connectivity to promote industries. A strong network of roads and railways is spread across the state," he added.

The CM said the GST system implemented in the country on the concept of One Nation One Tax is very effective. Simplification of the GST process has not only benefited the entrepreneurs, but the revenue of the government is also increasing, he added.

Khattar said more than 50 per cent of Haryana falls in the National Capital Region and the state government is developing this area as a logistics hub.

Mann terms allegation 'baseless' over Punjab minister's 'obscene' video

Ahead of the bypoll for May 10 Jalandhar Lok Sabha seat, Opposition Congress has accused a minister in the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) government of "sexual misconduct" on the basis of "video clips" and demanded his ouster even as the Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann on Tuesday termed the allegation 'baseless'.

Without naming anyone, Congress leader Sukhpal Singh Khaira, who on Sunday claimed to have submitted "highly objectionable video clips of gross misconduct by an AAP minister" to Punjab Governor Banwarilal Purohit, today said the Governor has forwarded the "sleazy video" of AAP minister to Chandigarh Police to verify its authenticity sought its forensic report.

Khaira claimed the contents of the videos were so objectionable that a viewer cannot watch them even for 15-20 seconds. He said the two clips were of four-minute and eight-minute duration.

Adding fuel to the fire, Bharatiya Janata Party leader Manjinder Singh Sirsa claimed "highly obscene videos of AAP minister Lal Chand Kataruchak have been submitted to Governor Punjab". In a tweet, Sirsa claimed "the minister has tendered his resignation...."

The CM, however, claimed he did not receive any resignation or video. He said Khaira has earlier made allegation against the food, civil supplies and consumer affairs minister Kataruchak regarding appointment of his son as his telephone attendant and his nephew (sister-in-law's son) as his special assistant which was also baseless.

"Khaira should tell the media that if Kataruchak was

indulging in any impropriety, why did his political alliance field Kataruchak as candidate in the 2019 Parliamentary elections," Mann asked. A splinter group of AAP, Punjab Democratic Alliance (PDA) which was led by Khaira who later joined Congress, had fielded Kataruchak (52) from Gurdaspur in the 2019 Lok Sabha elections.

The CM said the allegations showed that Opposition was not getting any issues ahead of the Lok Sabha bypoll in Jalandhar. An MLA from Bhoja in Pathankot, Kataruchak has also rejected Khaira's allegations saying Khaira's main job is to remain in the media by creating sensationalism and taking political mileage out of it.

Khaira, however, said the CM was running away from giving satisfactory answers to scandals by his ministers like Kataruchak. He said by doing this, Mann has "admitted their guilt and is shamelessly defending their misconduct and cheating".

The Congress leader said there couldn't be a more lame excuse offered by Mann to defend Ministers like Kataruchak saying why we couldn't find fault in him during 2019 LS elections. "How would I know in 2019 what a person would do in 2023? It shows the coward in CM," Khaira said in a tweet.

Leader of Opposition and Congress leader Partap Singh Bajwa said the charges made by Khaira against the Cabinet minister of AAP are very serious. "I request the Honourable Governor to get an independent inquiry done in the matter and make the name of the tainted minister public. The said minister should be dropped till the time inquiry..." he said in a tweet.

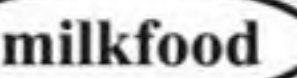
Srinagar Police said that the chargesheet has been filed in the court of Chief Judicial Magistrate (CJM) Srinagar.
