Fire breaks out in auto-rickshaw in Karnataka: A fire broke out in an auto rickshaw in the Kanknadi police station area on Saturday at around 5 pm. Bharat Jodo Yatra: MP govt ensures foolproof security

A day after an anonymous letter threatening to assassinate Rahul Gandhi and state Congress chief Kamal Nath along with threats of serial blasts in Indore came to the fore, Madhya Pradesh Home Minister Narottam Mishra ruled out the possibility of a threat to Bharat Jodo Yatra in the state.

Responding to an alleged threatening letter, which was reportedly received by an Indore shop owner on Thursday, Mishra said the state government has ensured to provide full security for Rahul Gandhi's yatra in Madhya Pradesh.

"The government is responsible for the foolproof security of Rahul Gandhi during the Bharat Jodo Yatra in Madhya Pradesh. I want to assure them that it is our commitment as far as providing security is concerned," Mishra said on Saturday.



Taking a jibe, Mishra said, "Perhaps, Kamal Nath does not want Rahul Gandhi's yatra to come to Madhya Pradesh, that is why he is doing all these stunts." The anonymous letter threatened that bomb blasts would be carried out in that city if the Bharat Jodo Yatra made a scheduled night halt at Khalsa Stadium here on November 28. Indore police had said on Friday that a case has been lodged against an unidentified accused u/s 507 IPC (criminal intimidation) by an anonymous communication at Indore's Juni police station. Sources in the police also said that the top cops in Indore are

mulling over slapping the National Security Act (NSA) against the accused, once they get nabbed. The letter, which bears the photocopy of an election photo identity card (EPIC) of a Karnal-based youth, is written in Hindi. Containing abusive language, the letter, while mentioning the 1984 anti-Sikh riots, points to Kamal Nath's alleged role in the targeted killings of the Sikh community. Khalsa Stadium in Indore was in news earlier this month after there was a controversy over Nath being felicitated at a function held there on the occasion of Guru Nanak Jayanti on November 8. Kirtan singer Manpreet Singh Kanpuri had referred to the 1984 anti-Sikh riots, regarding which Nath had faced allegations in the past, and blasted the organisers for felicitating Nath. The BJP has already announced that if Nath enters the stadium during the Bharat Jodo Yatra, it will be shown black flags.

Maha rejigs 14-member panel for border row with Karnataka

A fortnight after the Governors of Maharashtra and Karnataka met, the Maharashtra government has recast its all-party 14-member high power committee (HPC) on the old boundary row affecting the two states, officials said here on Saturday. The HPC headed by Chief Minister Eknath Shinde comprises Deputy CM Devendra Fadnis, Union Minister Narayan Rane, and ministers Chandrakant Patil, Suresh Khade, Tanaji Swant, Ravindra Chavan, Deepak Kesarkar, Shambhuj Desai from the ruling Balasahebani Shiv Sena (BSS) and Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP).

Also included are former Union Minister and Nationalist Congress Party President Sharad Pawar and NCP's Leader of Opposition in Maharashtra Assembly Ajit Pawar, Leader of Opposition in Council Ambadas Danve of Shiv Sena (UBT), Congress' former CM Prithviraj Chavan, and others. The HPC has been entrusted with determining the future course to resolve the long-delayed border dispute and take necessary decisions and action in the matter, as per notification. Established in May 2000, earlier the HPC was revamped

in May 2014, June 2014, March 2015, and September 2020, and has been done for the fifth time now after the change of government in the state last June. Maharashtra has laid a claim over some 7,000 sq km area along the border with Karnataka comprising 814 predominantly Marathi-speaking villages in Belgaum, Uttara Kannada, Bidar and Gulbarga and the towns of Belgavi, Karwar and Nippani.

Gangrape in moving car: Woman among four arrested in Kerala

Kerala police have arrested four persons, three men and a Rajasthani woman, on charges of raping a 19-year-old model inside a moving car in Kochi.

Kochi City Police Commissioner CH Nagaraju said that the police recorded the arrest of all four accused in the gang-rape of a model in Kochi on Thursday night. Earlier, police have taken

Dimple Lamba (Dolly), hailing from Rajasthan, and Kodungalur natives, Vivek, Sudeep, and Nithin, into custody in connection with the alleged gangrape that took place in a moving car in Kochi. It is learnt that the three men are Dimple Lamba's friends.

The City police commissioner said that the probe team also slapped conspiracy charges against the accused. The victim was convinced and brought to the bar

in the name of a DJ party. Dimple Lamba who is also active in the modelling field was acquainted with the victim.

Police said they were investigating the background of the four accused and will produce them before court soon.

The accused were charged under sections for criminal conspiracy, rape, and kidnapping among others.

Meanwhile, the police have recorded the state-

ment of the 19-year-old victim, who hails from Kasargod. The victim reportedly told the police that her modelling friend Dimple Lamba took her to a bar near Cochiln shipyard where she was given beer mixed with some intoxicant. After drinking it, the girl collapsed.

"I was gang-raped by three men for so many times as they drove the car around the city on Thursday night," she reportedly told the police. The accused then

dropped her at her apartment in Kakkannad. It was the survivor's friend that informed the police about the incident and shifted her to a hospital. The girl is currently undergoing treatment at Kalamassery Medical College hospital. The girl told the police that she could identify all the men who sexually assaulted her in the car.

Responding to the incident, leader of Opposition in the Assembly VD Satheesan said that the news that a 19-

year-old girl was gang raped in a moving car in Kochi city is shocking. He also asked whether this is the women's safety that the government is always propagating.

The opposition leader said in a statement that the police had also failed to notice the gang-rape that took place on a public street

"A girl was gang-raped for three-and-a-half hours on a public street in a lively city, but the police did not notice it," Satheesan said.

It's 'neither publicity nor a stunt', says IAS officer after EC move

Abhishek Singh, the IAS officer who was barred from election duty for sharing his posting on Instagram, said that it was "neither publicity nor a stunt".

Taking to Twitter on Friday night, he said: "I accept the Hon'ble EC's decision with all humility. Though I believe there's nothing wrong in this post. A public servant, in a car bought by public's money, reporting for public duty, with public officials, communicating it to the public. It is neither publicity nor a stunt!" His remarks came hours after the Election Commission said that it removed Singh from election duty after he shared his posting as General Observer on the social media platform.

"Now, it has come to the notice of the Commission



that Sh. Abhishek Singh, IAS (UP:2011) has used social media platform 'Instagram' for sharing his posting/joining as General Observer and used his official position as a publicity stunt," the EC said in its order. Singh was appointed as General Observer for Assembly Constituency 49-Bapunagar and 56-Asarwa of Gujarat's Ahmedabad district.

International Gita Mahotsav gets underway in Kurukshetra

The International Gita Mahotsav (IGM)-2022 took off to a grand start on Saturday with inauguration of Saras Mela in Kurukshetra by Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar.

Addressing devotees, the CM said the main programme of IGM-2022 will formally begin on November 29 after the inauguration by the President, Droupadi Murmu. Khattar later also met the artists and craftsmen amidst a wonderful confluence of dhool-nagadas, craftsmen and artists. He congratulated and extended best wishes to the people involved in the organising of this event.

"Thousands of years ago, on the land of Kurukshetra, Lord Shri Krishna delivered an immortal message for humanity which is enshrined in the holy Bhagavad Gita. The message and teachings



preached by Lord Krishna still hold the same relevance as they did then. The message of Gita will be remembered for ages," he said.

The CM said celebrations of IGM-2022 are not limited to Kurukshetra only but this holy grand festival of Gita has been successfully celebrated at the international level

also. He said devotees from all over the country and abroad will attend IGM-2022. It is expected that in the post-Covid-19 pandemic times, devotees will be reaching in large numbers.

Along with this, artists, craftsmen, artisans and self-help groups from different provinces have reached the

IGM-2022 to display their skills and products.

The CM said this time a separate stall has been set up for the handicraft makers of Haryana, which has become a centre of attraction for foreign tourists. Such initiatives certainly provide employment to the local people along with giving a golden opportunity for the tourists to become familiar with Haryana's culture. Foreign tourists from 25 countries are expected to visit the IGM-2022, he added.

Khattar said passengers from 10 districts travelling to IGM-2022 will get a 50 per cent concession in state transport buses from 19 November to 6 December. People coming from Kurukshetra, Karnal, Panipat, Jind, Kaithal, Panchkula, Ambala, Yamunanagar, Sonapat and Rohtak districts have been provided concession in bus fare on reaching Kurukshetra, he informed.

Assam's elephant Joymala still in chains

Leased out of Assam more than a decade back, an elephant Joymala (also known as Jeymalyatha) continues to be shackled in chains in a Tamil Nadu temple. People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals (PeTA) India, which brought the female elephant's issue to the public, also added that Joymala is kept in complete isolation from others of her kind.

Presently in the custody of Tamil Nadu's Srivilliputhur Nachiyar Thirukovil temple, Joymala was claimed to be fine by the State's Hindu religious and charitable endowments department few days back, but PeTA India through its latest video evidence refuted it and asserted that the elephant has not been returned to the custodian in Assam even though the permit had already expired.

The organisation affirms that Joymala is living with deep wounds on legs indicating her long-term chaining. After a veterinary inspection visit was made to Joymala in July, it submitted a report to Tamil Nadu



officials explaining that her feet are painfully infected and Joymala was controlled with pliers.

"She (Joymala) is forced to live on unhealthy surfaces that lead to infection and osteomyelitis. No visitors are allowed to enter the area where Joymala is now kept. Enough is enough. It is high time for Joymala to be sent to a rehabilitation centre, where she can feel safe, recover from her trauma, and be in the company of other elephants," said PeTA India's campaign manager Radhika Suryavanshi.

Assam environment & forest department is also seeking directions for the transfer of abused Joymala back to the State from Tamil Nadu through Gauhati High Court. However, PeTA India recommends Joymala be sent to a specialised rehabilitation centre skilled in handling abused elephants, as approved by the Union government's Project Elephant division, where she can live unchained and in the company of other elephants.

But Joymala is not the only elephant leased out of Assam as a convincing source

claims that no less than hundred elephants have been leased (or sold in secret) in the last decade. The State forest department, which provides a certificate for transferring an elephant from one place to another, needs to clarify that it has not leased or sold Joymala to TN temple authority, rather it was taken from a private owner following some understanding, best known to the individual and Joymala's present custodian.

Soumyadeep Datta, a wildlife expert associated with the Union government's Project Elephant initiative, argues that the elephant, even though it may be domesticated, is always recognised as wild in India and hence the forest authorities have some responsibilities all the time. He argued that if anyone wants to lease an elephant (for being unable to support the care or any other reason), the forest department avoids giving permission and the owner should be advised (directed) to release it in the wild following necessary preparations.

Odisha repeals Covid restrictions

With the improvement in Covid-19 pandemic situation, Odisha government on Saturday withdrew all Covid-19 related restrictions and penalties imposed on gatherings, wearing masks, spitting, etc in 2020.

"In view of the substantial decline of Covid-19 cases in the state over the past

several months, the government has been pleased to repeal the Odisha Covid-19 Regulations, 2020 as amended from time to time with immediate effect," read a notification issued by the state health department.
